some island groups, one of which is the Faroe Islands.

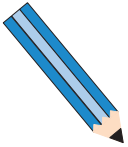
Sports, however, isn't only about competing.

What importance does sport have in *your* life?

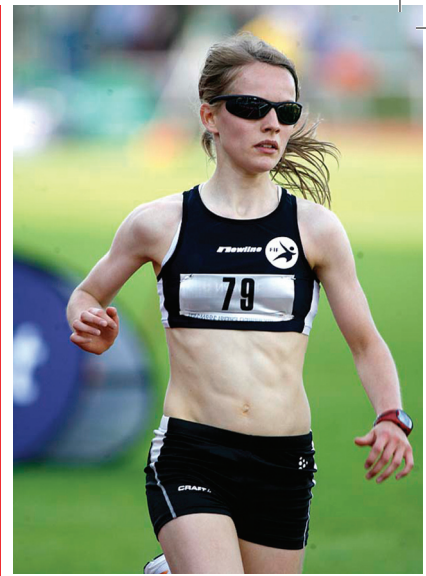

Do you buy any special brands?

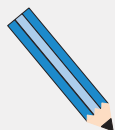
Are there shops that are especially popular?
